- Staff and clients will conform to all mandated protocols and keep up with such protocols as they change.
- Staff will be asked to monitor their health and contact history as well as wash hands between clients and as often as needed throughout the day.
- Hand washing signs are posted in the bathrooms.
- Social distancing will be followed as much as possible.
- Masks must be worn by clients and staff.
- All existing sanitation/disinfection procedures mandated by the state board of cosmetology will continue to be followed with the addition of stepped up sanitation of common areas - such as door knobs, light switches, reception area, and bathrooms.
- Body temperature will be checked upon arrival for both staff and clients.
- Clients will not be allowed to bring extra friends or family along, unless they have an appointment also.
- Staff and clients will be expected to reschedule appointments, if they have a fever.
